

## TRAFFIC INFORMATION: YOUR GUIDE TO ACCESSING THE SKI AREA

**Dear customers, dear skiing enthusiasts, welcome to Châtel!**

For the new week ahead, which promises to be magnificent, we would like to share some key tips for a smooth and peaceful skiing experience.

Access to one of our main areas, Pré la Joux, is exclusively via dedicated ski shuttles. Our car parks at the foot of the slopes do not have the capacity to accommodate all vehicles during this very busy period.

Therefore, to ensure everyone's comfort, the number one tip is simple: leave your car in the car park at your accommodation.

This arrangement, which was successfully implemented last week during the holidays, has proven its effectiveness. It allows our reinforced network of free shuttle buses to run smoothly.

### **For our guests staying in Châtel: Your 5 access points**

Choose the access that suits you best based on your accommodation location and your preferences!

#### **OPTION 1 : Access via the village centre (Super Châtel gondola lift)**

- **How?** Access is **only possible on foot**. There is no drop-off point or car park nearby.
- **Which ski slopes?** Direct access to the Super Châtel area and connections to Switzerland and La Chapelle d'Abondance. Option to switch via the Portes du Soleil and Gabelou chairlifts to the Linga, Pré la Joux and Avoriaz areas.

#### **OPTION 2 : Access via Petit-Châtel (Petit Châtel chairlift)**

- **How?** Accessible on foot for local residents or via shuttle buses.
- **Which ski slopes?** Access to the Barbossine sector and connections to Torgon, Super-Châtel and all the ski areas.

#### **OPTION 3 : Access via Vannes (by shuttle bus)**

- **How?** Your shuttle bus will drop you off at the terminus (drop-off zone only, no parking).
- **Which ski slopes?** Take the Portes du Soleil chairlift (towards Super Châtel) or the Gabelou chairlift (towards Linga, Pré la Joux and then Avoriaz).

#### **OPTION 4 : Acces via Linga (by shuttle bus)**

- **How?** Main access point by shuttle bus, at the foot of the Linga gondola lift.
- **Which ski slopes?** Direct access to the Linga/Plaine Dranse area and connections to Avoriaz.

#### **OPTION 5 : DIRECT access to Pré la Joux (only by dedicated shuttle buses)**

- **How?** Special authorised shuttle buses will transport you directly via a secure route.
- **Which ski slopes?** You will be dropped off at the Pré la Joux and Pierre Longue chairlift departure points.
